Sara: That's his wife, Diana.


Ben: Have they got children?


Sara: No, they haven't.

<i>Have got</i> Affirmative (+)	
I've got He/she/it got You/ we/ they got	<i>interrogative (?)</i> Have I got? Has she/he/it got? you, we, they got?
Negative (-) You/ I got He/ she/ it got we/ they got	<i>short answers</i> Yes he/she/it has. No, he/she/it hasn't. Yes, you/we/they have got No, you/we/they
